### Pat Tillman Foundation


Our "Heroes" theme included recognition of those who served our country in the armed services. Our local hero, Pat Tillman, left his professional career as an Arizona Cardinal and enlisted in the United



States Army in June 2002 in the aftermath of the September 11, 2001, attacks. He joined the Army Rangers and served several tours in combat before he died in the mountains of Afghanistan. Lieutenant General Stanley A. McChrystal approved the award of a Silver Star to Pat recognized for his

dedicated service and sacrifice for our country.

The Cardinals retired his number 40, and Arizona State did the same for the number 42 he wore with the Sun Devils. The Cardinals have named the plaza surrounding their University of Phoenix Stadium in Glendale Pat Tillman Freedom Plaza. On November 12, 2006, a bronze statue was revealed in his honor. ASU also named the entryway to Sun Devil Stadium the "Pat Tillman Memorial Tunnel" and added a "PT-42" patch to their uniforms as permanent feature.



After his death, the Pat Tillman Foundation was established to carry forward its view of Tillman's legacy by inspiring and supporting those striving for positive change in themselves and the world. More information on the Foundation can be found at their website.

### Treasure Hunt Sites - 2011 Voting Results

At each Award banquet, the Hunters are asked to Rate the Clue Sites. The rating looks for the Top most popular Sites as well as the least popular Site. Voting is done during breakfast and the results shared during the awards ceremony.

Top sites are recognized for their challenge, creativity and fun! This year Hunters really enjoyed the Tilt Maze site. The maze required teamwork to maneuver the wooden ball through the path avoiding the holes and getting around the barriers. Teams also favored the Amelia Earhart Site where they folded and flew their paper airplanes, The Robin Hood Site where they shot arrows wearing tights, and the Marie Curie Site where they had to mix solutions to get their precipitate – and their answer.

The least popular Site gets recognized for a variety of reasons. For some it's the difficulty, others it's how it was set up or where it's located. Sometimes it's the concept itself...a real "groaner" that no one gets and incorrectly solves to a wrong icon. This least popular Site is named for the first such Site from the 1995 Hunt - "Florist Grumpy", where Hunters were to solve an image of Walt Disney's "Grumpy" holding a bouquet of Flowers in a Florist window as ... Forrest Gump! Unfortunately teams solved Grumpy to another Disney Icon on the Icon sheet and went off to a false site.

The least popular Site recognized by the Hunters was the Underdog word puzzle Site. The quiz was not a problem, but unscrambling the letters to the somewhat difficult "Seniorita Rio" resulted in many Help calls! Coming in a close second was the Country Western "name that Tune" Site. Guess not many Hunters have "Shutters and Boards" on their iPods.

Alas, we had a true "Florist Grumpy" site in TH11. The "Wanted Posters" Clue located inside the Peoria Police Station was clever and had actual participation by the Police at the Site. Unfortunately, there was an unforeseen participant as well - a memorial display to 9/11 located in the Station lobby, which observant Hunters identified and associated with the false Flight 93 icon. For Hunters who missed the 9/11 memorial and proceeded to solve the Wanted Posters clue, the Site rated very high, for those mislead by the 9/11 memorial, well....




