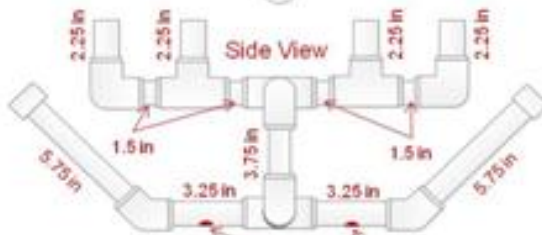


HINTS WISE OR OTHERWISE

(1) ACME Tau Device Assembly Instructions



Top View



Side View



End View

NOTES:

- All components are 1/2 inch PVC
- All dimensions are +/- 0.05 inch
- All dimensions are pre-assembly
- Glue all pieces together

- Drill a 1/8 inch hole centered on the bottom of the two 3.25 inch PVC pipe pieces.
- Holes are centered on the length of each pipe section

 6 - 90 degree elbows
 2 - crosses
 2 - 45 degree elbows
 2 - tees
 2 - end caps
 1/2 inch PVC pipe
 PVC glue

 drill

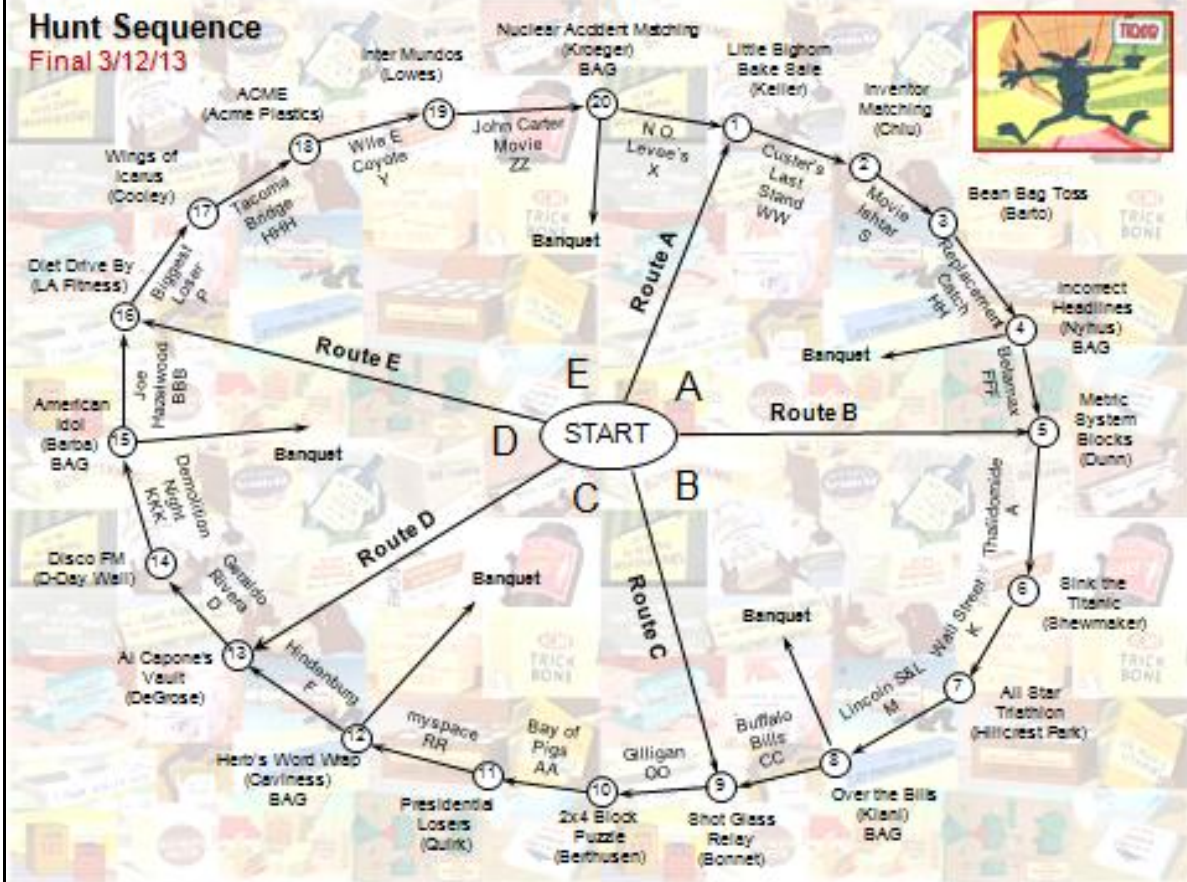


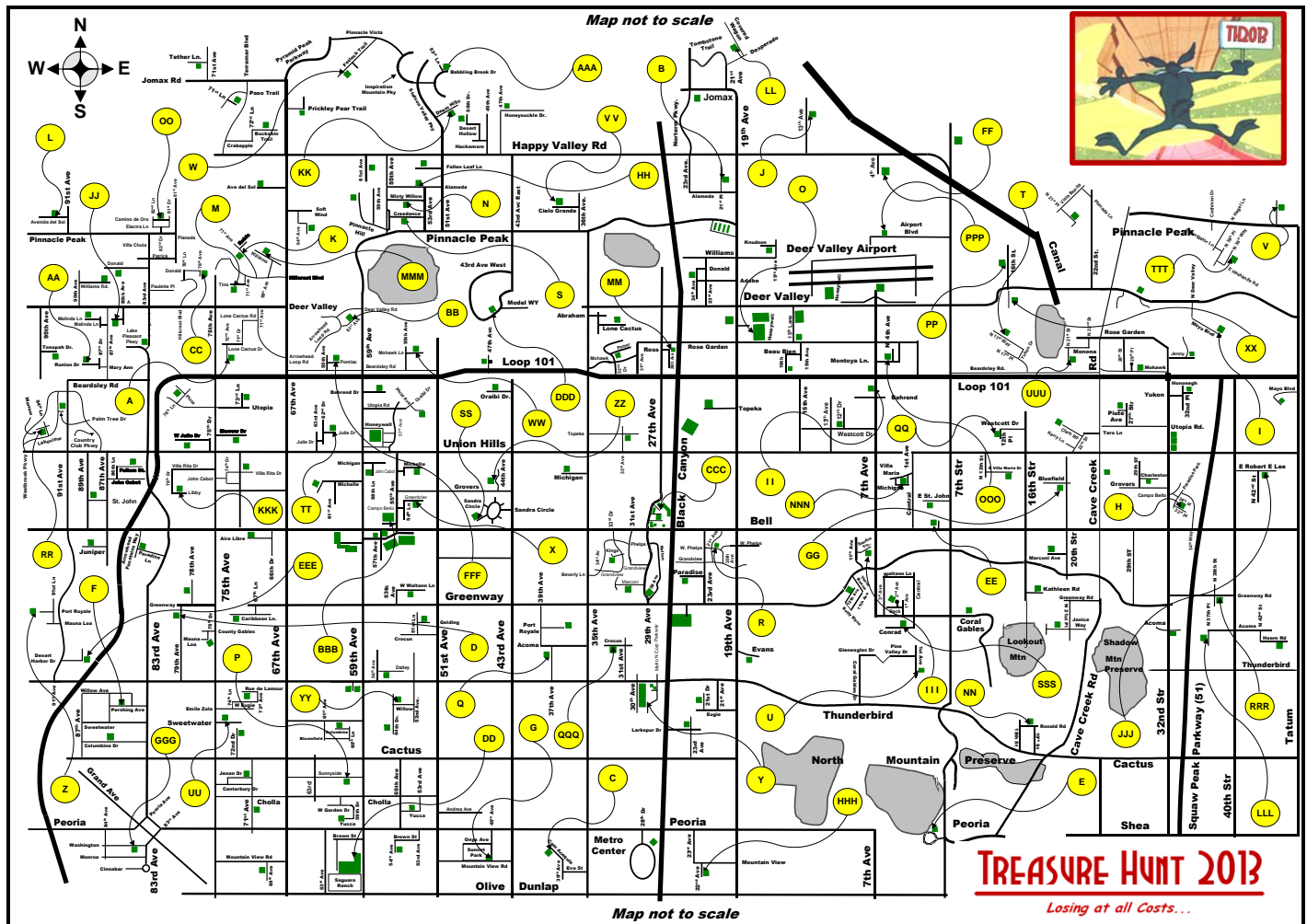

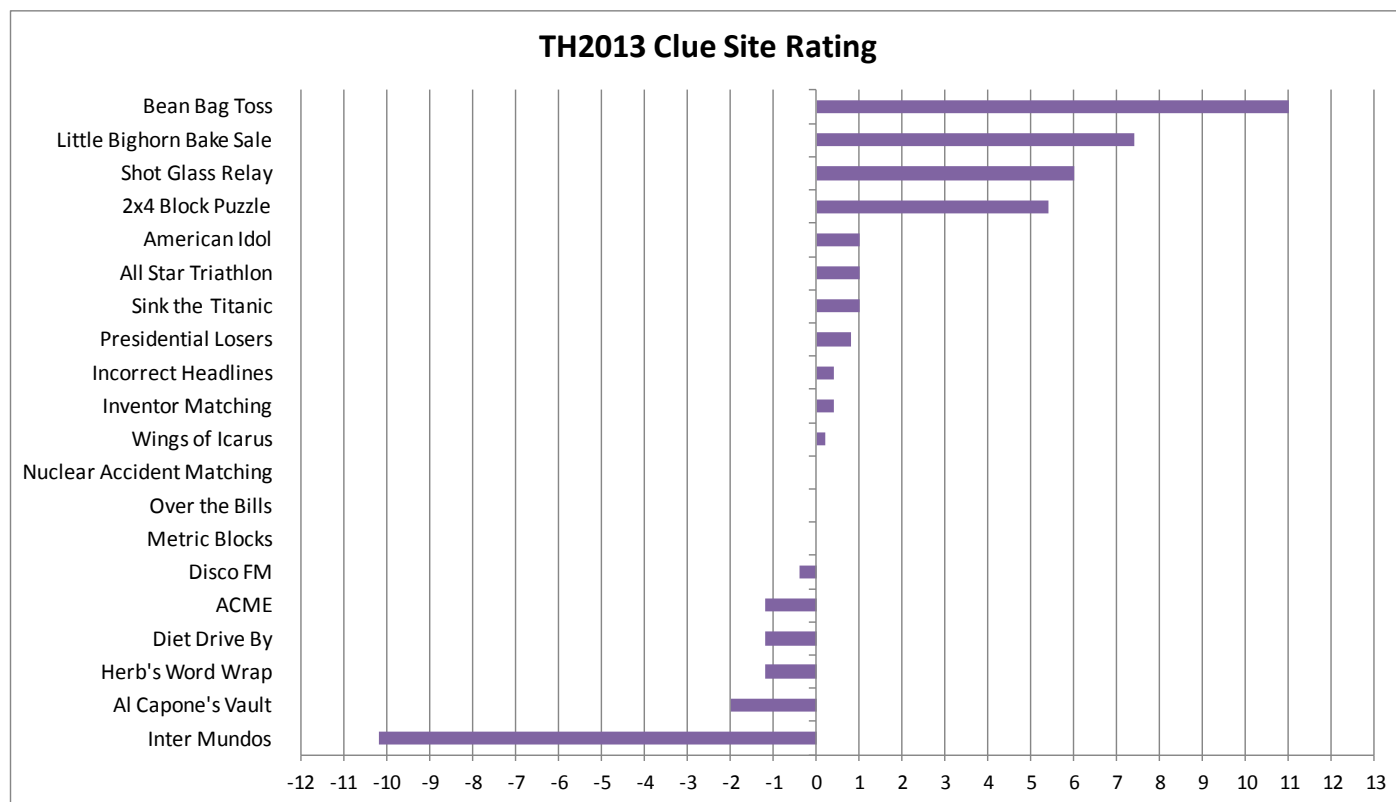
